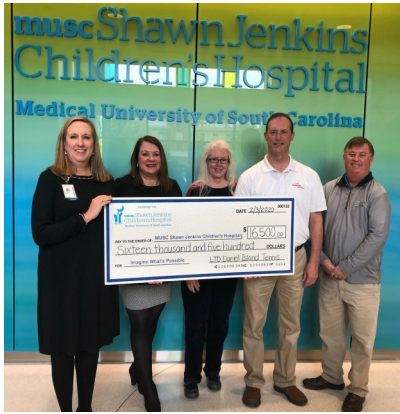
Family Weekend Saturday, April 4, - Sunday, April 5
